

ROADS COMMITTEE REPORT

Friday, April 20, 2007

Report respectfully presented to Council from the Road's Committee meeting held as a Committee of the Whole, on Friday April 20, 2007 at 13:55 h. in Council Chambers.

Road Super – Wilfred Lamure

1. Road Super's Report
 - a. Wash out on Francoeur Road – not accessible – road blocked and marked – needs culvert extension (near Hanlon's Point)
 - b. Dunlop Crescent – repaired, requires additional gravel, municipal staff to make new property owners aware of situation with suggestions to repair
 - c. Grading – options, timing – check with Leveque Bros.
 - d. Gravel or crushed asphalt from Leveque Bros. to use over existing roads that have pit run – Terry to enquire
 - e. Harvey Creek Road and culvert – check with Leveque Bros.
2. Roads working document and Report
 - a. Harvey Creek Road and Special Projects Amount – discussed situation of bank erosion and width of road; decided that the best, most cost effective solution is to move the guard rails closer to the road.
 - b. That Road Super contact Leveque Bros. on Monday, April 23, 2007 to rent grader, request use of waste crushed asphalt and gravel for use on our roads, monitor guard rails on Harvey Creek Road.
3. Unfinished Business
 - a. Adelard Road – continue to maintain or absolve, look into legal options – ask what they are, can we simply stop maintaining it?
 - b. Plowing contract – dates OK'd – clerk to advertise asap;
4. New Business
 - a. Road Tour – Councillor Gibson recommends attendance with working document – Monday April 30, 2007, 8:00 h, those interested please attend
 - b. Return to work date – will be decided between Clerk and Road Super
 - c. Plowing end of Boudreau Road – no longer year round residence
 - d. Ditching/culverts on Boudreau Road Doucette/Clouthier residences – options ditch to highway, need to confer with MTO
 - e. Ditching and culvert along Yate's Road – has been advised to write a letter to Council with concerns

Questions

What happens to tools etc. during repair of garage? Will deal with that when the time comes.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the guard rails along Harvey Creek Road be moved away from the bank.
2. That the snowplow contract be advertised as soon as possible, tenders to be opened June 1, 2007 at council meeting.
3. That Boudreau Road is no longer plowed beyond the turn-around near Edgewater Way.
