

**THE CORPORATION OF THE UNITED TOWNSHIPS OF HEAD,  
CLARA & MARIA**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 2008- 20**

**BEING** a By-Law to close to vehicular traffic on a temporary basis, a portion of municipal highway under the jurisdiction of Council for the dedication of the Veteran's Memorial.

**WHEREAS** *The Municipal Act* S.O. 2001, as amended, Chapter 25, Section 11 (3) states that a lower-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting matters within specific spheres of jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** highways, including parking and traffic on highways is one of those spheres of jurisdiction;

**AND WHEREAS** section 35 specifically states that a municipality may pass by-laws removing or restricting the common law right of passage by the public over a highway and the common law right of access to the highway by an owner of land abutting a highway;

**AND WHEREAS** the Veteran's Memorial ceremony will take place on Saturday, August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2008, at 14:00 hours in front of the Township Office and Committee members require time to prepare for the event;

**AND WHEREAS** the temporary closure of certain highways or portions thereof, within the municipality is deemed necessary for event purposes and such action is in accordance with the above referenced Act;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does enact as follows:

1. **THAT** a temporary closure, to through traffic, of part of Township Hall Road, from the Township Office to the Township Garage, delineated by traffic cones, barricades, fences and/or other suitable markers, will occur for the dedication of the Veteran's Memorial;
2. **THAT** the road closure will occur between the hours of 07:00 hours and 17:00 hours on Saturday, August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2008;
3. **THAT** the Memorial Committee be given permission to use Township equipment to create the barriers and to direct traffic for parking purposes on that day;
4. **THAT** the local Department of the Ontario Provincial Police, the County of Renfrew, the County Emergency Services Director, the Township of Head, Clara & Maria Roads Department shall be notified directly upon the passing of this By-Law and a Notice will be posted at all locations normally used for posting Council business.

**READ** a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> time this 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 2008

**READ** a 3<sup>rd</sup> time short and finally passed this 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 2008
