Subject: Authorization for municipal cheque signing and borrowing – for 2010 until after elections.

RECOMMENDATION: That Council adopt the following resolution appointing members to specific duties relating to signing municipal cheques and to borrowing small amounts of money for a short term for routine business transactions.

Resolution #1

BE IT RESOLVED THAT for purposes of completing budgeted, emergency or specifically approved financial transactions for the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria, cheque signing authority is hereby granted to: Reeve Stewart with Councillor Aiston and Councillor Gibson as alternates for Council; and the Clerk-Melinda Reith with the Treasurer- Ruth Morin as alternate for administration. All cheques are to be signed by one representative of Council and one representative of administration.

Resolution #2

WHEREAS certain routine business transactions require a business credit card to complete;
AND WHEREAS all procurement must follow the guidelines as documented in the Municipal Procurement By-law;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Clerk- Melinda Reith, Treasurer-Ruth Morin, and Road Superintendent-Wilfred Lamure are hereby authorized to borrow on behalf of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria from the Bank of Nova Scotia from time to time by way of a Visa Credit Card, a total sum not to exceed five thousand dollars Canadian (\$5,000.00) at any time.

AND FURTHER THAT this resolution hereby rescinds any previous borrowing resolutions.
