Subject: As per request of the Federal Government in order to obtain funding through the Community Infrastructure Improvement Fund.

RECOMMENDATION: Council is required to authorize the entering into an agreement to proceed with the funding for the CIIF grant.

WHEREAS the Municipality of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria has been successful in obtaining grant funding through the Federal Government's Community Infrastructure Improvement Fund in the amount of \$70,250;

AND WHEREAS the project applied for and funded is entitled "Expansion of Community Centre/Library Facility;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it viable and necessary to proceed with the expansion project;

You should be aware of section 8.1 (i) of the Agreement "all information provided during the CIIF application process remains true, correct and complete in every respect except as set out to the contrary herein." and section 8.2 of the agreement which states – "The Recipient covenants and agrees that:(a) it shall obtain the prior written consent of the Minister before making any change to any aspect of the Project or to the management of the Project or Recipient."

This means that no changes may be made to the proposed project (including the need for accessible washrooms) without resubmitting them for approval. Modifications may affect the outcome of the decision.
