**NOTES TO CONTRIBUTOR**

Only persons normally resident in Ontario, corporations carrying on business in Ontario, or trade unions holding bargaining rights for employees in Ontario, including central, regional or district labour councils, may contribute up to \$750.00 to a candidate for municipal office. A contributor shall not make contributions exceeding a total of \$5,000.00 to candidates for office on the same council.

These contributions are not eligible for a property tax credit/rebate or a federal income tax receipt.

The name and address of contributors, who make contributions of over \$100.00 must be reported in the candidate's financial disclosure and will be posted on the Municipality's website. This information is deemed to be public records pursuant to the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*.

An individual who is convicted of an offence under the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996*, is liable to a fine of not more than \$25,000.00 in addition to any other penalties provided for in the Act. A Corporation or trade union, if convicted, is liable to a fine of not more than \$50,000.00 in addition to any other penalties provided for in the Act.
