Canada Day – committee member recruiting and update

Would like to try to raise money from Canada Day 2016 in order to transfer proceeds to Canada Day 2017 to make it a bigger and better celebration.

Melinda received quotes for rental equipment:

Dunk Tank Rental – \$175/day. Need to sell balls 35 balls @ \$5 each to break even.

Popcorn Machine Rental - \$60/day. Need to sell 81 cups of popcorn at \$2.00 to break even. Snow Cone Machine Rental - \$60/day. Need to sell 48 snow cones at 2.00 to break even. It would cost \$488.16 in rental fees for all three pieces, including all of the supplies required for each piece of equipment. Rec Committee needs to advertise early. Using pictures and not just writing will attract more attention to the advertisements.

Action: Melinda to reserve the three pieces of equipment at \$488.16.

We have one inflatable included in the budget for Canada Day 2016, which is confirmed with rental company. Need to look at options and pick one.

Action: Gayle to pick inflatable and put deposit down on it.

Action: Melinda to purchase maple candy on a stick before it is no longer stocked.

Outdoor Bingo – outdoors at Canada Day 2016 under tent with wooden tables. Fee for bingo, prizes of everyday use (umbrella, sunscreen etc.) Is this something suitable for Canada Day 2016?

Canada Day Volunteers – Betty, Marlene, Paul.

<u>DRDCF Grant</u> - Application has been submitted, requested \$5000.00 for new play structure to be installed on Township property.

TSC signs- Gayle provided pictures of the signs out on the trail. They look great.
