**Subject:** Review of the New Code of conduct for Employees.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Council of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does hereby agree to adopt the presented Code of Conduct for use for employees commencing immediately.

## **Background/Executive Summary:**

As the former document existed to attempt to provide guidelines for both staff and Council members and was not specific to each group and due to the challenges over the past year; it is felt that two separate documents are required so that each party knows which sections apply specifically to them.

The existing document has been modified; sections have been added to provide clarity and explanation. Those parts specific to Council or committee members have been removed. Some clarification of duties and process has occurred. As municipal employee performance is an HR matter, breaches and investigations are administrative in nature and should be handled as such.

Codes of conduct from other municipalities have been reviewed and appropriate sections incorporated into ours.
