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Procedure By-law

Subject:

Simple amendment to the Procedure By-law.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the following resolution be adopted by Council ensuring compliance with legislation.

WHEREAS section 238 of the *Municipal Act* requires that a municipality shall have a Procedure By-law;

AND WHEREAS by having within that by-law a mechanism to suspend the rules of the by-law defeats the purpose of the legislation and results in the Council being non-compliant;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT by-law 2008-10 be amended by striking section 2.2 fulfilling this requirement.

BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

During the governance training with Fred Dean back in February, Fred recommended that any Procedure By-laws with "suspension" clauses have them amended to remove them. The reasoning is that the Municipal Act requires that a municipality have a Procedure By-Law to govern the calling place and procedures of Council meetings. If the rules are suspended, the Procedure By-law is no longer in place and the municipality would then be without one contrary to section 238 of the Municipal Act.

Policy Impact:

Amends policy to ensure compliance with the letter and intent of the legislation.
