BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The by-law requires a report to Council listing all documents signed under its authority for the calendar year. From the by-law...

“NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the United Townships of Head, Clara & Maria does hereby enact as follows:

1. **THAT** the Head of Council and/or the Clerk/CAO are hereby authorized to execute agreements, contracts, or other documents and consents which are routine in nature and are required to finalize a previous action taken by Council through direction to staff and to affix the Corporate Seal to it.
2. **THAT** the agreements, contracts or other documents and consents include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Contracts awarding tenders where the awarding of such tender has been approved by resolution of Council or as per the procurement by-law where Council specific approval is not required;
 - b. Contracts for public utilities such as agreements with Bell Canada and/or Hydro One for routine service or installation on municipal property;
 - c. Standard agreements to provide for consulting, auditing, legal and/or engineering services where the approval to engage such a consultant for compensation and for particular works has previously been approved by Council;
 - d. Employment Contracts;
 - e. MNR Wildfire Protection Agreements;
 - f. Grant Applications;

- g. Agreements required to be entered into as a condition of approval of a land severance or zoning amendment approved by the County of Renfrew Planning Department or the Ontario Municipal Board; and
- h. Any other routine agreement/contract which does not require a specific authorizing by-law but of which Council has prior knowledge and has given prior approval.”
