Subject: Auto Extrication, municipal responsibility and liability

RECOMMENDATION:

Confirmation that Council's decision to discontinue auto-extrication services was lawful.

BACKGROUND/EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The municipal solicitors, Cunningham Swan, have confirmed the position and advice previously provided to council by the municipal insurer and staff.

Provision of auto-extrication services is not mandatory. Assuming that policy decision was made considering legislation and responsibility, in good faith, there is no increased liability with not providing the service.

There is however; always increased liability through negligence when a policy is created and is not operationally compliant. This was in part the basis for the discontinuation of the wildfire service – in the municipality's potential for exposure through negligence simply due to size and abilities. If we couldn't provide the service as per the Fire Marshal's/Minister's guidelines, we were open to liability.
