**AND WHEREAS** human trafficking is one of the fastest growing crimes that starts and stays in Canada, targeting victims – 90 percent of which are Canadian-born and predominantly female, averaging the age of 14;

**AND WHEREAS** human trafficking is in our neighbourhoods and our communities;
