Background/Executive Summary: There are two types of fireworks; there is the Professional and Family. The professional fireworks require a licensed operator to operate the function. The family firework does not require a licensed operator. The following is a list of companies and the prices for both professional and family fireworks.

Professional Fireworks: Hands Fireworks is a professional fireworks company who has been in business for over 100 years. They currently supply Deep River with their Canada Day fireworks. Canada Day celebrations cost Deep River \$5000.00 and Summerfest was \$10,000 and that is with the Deep River fire department detonating. Hands Fireworks staff will assist on design and set-up.

Victory Fireworks is a family fireworks company and they can supply a package for \$750.00 with a list on how to set it up. There would be no assistance on design or set-up other than a written list.

Options/Discussion:

1. Type of fireworks desired. Length of show. Professionalism desired.
2. Total costs.
3. Availability of qualified individual to light.

Financial Considerations/Budget Impact: A 20-25 minute show as per Deep River costs approximately \$5,000. The cost of attendant would be extra as Chief Hogue performs this service for Deep River. Family type fireworks would cost < \$1,000. There may be potential for funding from Heritage Canada once again.
