1. As discussed briefly, the Disposal Site Attendant position has been modified to merge the Labourer and Attendant duties and responsibilities. The new title is Municipal Maintenance Worker and has been allocated to the same Level on the salary grid at the Disposal Site Attendant's position was. As the Attendant's position was of higher qualifications, experience etc. than the labourer's and as we are not removing any of those responsibilities, we have simply merged the two. The new starting salary will be \$15.12 per hour.
2. Is Council interested in having someone from MPAC come and give a presentation? It could be as little as 10 minutes or up to an hour.
3. There is little interest in the community for representation at the County Expo 150 – June 9-12, 2011. Any ideas? At best, it looks like we might come up with a static display unless we can find interested individuals to volunteer.
4. Council has up to 60 days after assuming office to appoint Library Board Members. We are in the process of locating a fifth member; position has been posted with a deadline of January 15. Appointments will be made at the next meeting. If you know of anyone interested, please have them contact the office.
5. From last meeting – OMPF was shown as \$8,000 over budgeted due to posting error. Instead of PIL it was posted to OMPF. It has been corrected.
6. Report from Minister of Finance. OMPF allocations are higher than expected. The interim/transition funding has been extended avoiding another decrease this year. Payments for 2011 are lower by the \$43,800 lost last year but will total \$157,700 for 2011.
7. For those of you who have not already done so, March 25, 2011 is the deadline for Election Financial Statements. Legislation states that even though you did not run a campaign, you need to file the Form 4 or risk losing your seat.
8. Budget process has begun. Please advise any special projects/purchases you would like to consider at this time. We hope to have the budget completed by the end of February.
9. FYI - I have been made aware that Carol has been collecting garbage from the Brent Road for the past 5 years contrary to our policy. Trudy Miller brought this to my attention. I have sent letters to each resident restating Council policy however; I'm sure that there will be some fallout.
10. Canada Day Funding deadline is even earlier this year – January 15, 2011. Does Council wish to proceed with an application based on 2009 data (with cost of living increases)?
